

USS Ponchatoula (high tech) Display Piece



This handsome display piece is 6x8 inches. The back is made to accommodate wall mounting or free standing on a desk or book shelf. The steel was acquired by John Hearn and Jerry Mouton when they were rescuing artifacts for the city of Ponchatoula. This piece of steel was cut from the ship's 01 deck (you probably walked on it many times). The steel is held in place with a powerful magnet and *can* easily be lifted out for closer inspection and then set back into place. The picture was taken by myself in September 1963 in Hong Kong harbor. Our Association is offering these little beauties to the members for a mere \$38 plus \$12 shipping.
